Meaning: Palped: past tense of palp, meaning to examine or feel (a part of the body) with the hands to assess its condition or detect abnormalities.

1. The doctor carefully palped the patient's abdomen to check for any abnormalities.
2. During the examination, the vet palped the dog's limbs to assess its range of motion.
3. The archaeologist palped the ancient pottery to feel for any cracks or imperfections.
4. As part of the training, the students learned how to properly palped the various anatomical models.
5. She palped the fabric to determine its weight and texture before making her decision.
