Meaning: Palpi are elongated sensory appendages found in some arthropods, such as insects and crustaceans, that assist in navigation and tasting.

1. The insect's palpi are important sensory organs that help it navigate its environment.
2. In many species of crustaceans, the palpi are used to taste food before ingestion.
3. Researchers observed that the palpi of the moth were highly sensitive to pheromones.
4. During the dissection, the scientist noted the unique structure of the palpi in the specimen.
5. The palpi of certain arachnids can be quite complex, aiding in both movement and feeding.
