

# PAPPUS

*Meaning: PAPPUS: A tuft of fine hairs or bristles on the seed of certain plants, such as dandelions, that aids in wind dispersal.*

1. The pappus of the dandelion aids in its dispersal by wind.
2. Botanists often study the structure of the pappus to understand seed dispersal mechanisms.
3. In plants like milkweed, the pappus forms a fluffy crown that facilitates airborne seed travel.
4. The presence of a well-developed pappus can significantly enhance a plant's reproductive success.
5. During a nature walk, I observed how the pappus of the thistle floated gracefully through the air.
