*Meaning: Parallelism is the use of similar grammatical structures or patterns in writing or speech to create balance and enhance clarity or rhythm.*

2. In literature, parallelism often enhances the rhythm and clarity of the writing.
3. The architect emphasized parallelism in the design to create a sense of harmony.
4. Effective speeches often use parallelism to make key points more memorable.
5. The scientist noted the parallelism between the two studies, which yielded similar results.
