Meaning: To paralogize means to engage in reasoning that is logically flawed or to draw incorrect conclusions from premises.

1. The philosopher sought to paralogize the arguments of his opponents, demonstrating their logical flaws.
2. In her analysis, she warned against the tendency to paralogize the implications of the study, urging careful interpretation.
3. To paralogize is to construct a misleading argument that seems valid at first glance but ultimately fails under scrutiny.

5. When discussing ethical dilemmas, it's easy to paralogize the nuances and misrepresent the original intent.
