Meaning: To render someone or something unable to move or act effectively; to incapacitate.

1. The sudden storm seemed to paralyse the entire city, trapping residents in their homes.
2. Fear can often paralyse a person, preventing them from taking necessary risks.
3. The patient experienced a stroke that began to paralyse the left side of his body.
4. In her speech, she aimed to inspire action rather than allow despair to paralyse the community.
5. The unexpected news threatened to paralyse the negotiations, leaving both parties at a standstill.
