

PARAPODIUM

Meaning: Parapodium: a paired lateral outgrowth or appendage found in certain annelid worms, used for locomotion and respiration.

1. The parapodium of the marine worm assists in locomotion and gas exchange.
2. In some species, parapodia are brightly colored and serve to attract mates.
3. Researchers are studying the role of parapodium in the development of certain aquatic organisms.
4. The structure of the parapodium varies significantly across different phyla of annelids.
5. Using a microscope, the intricate details of the parapodium can be vividly observed.

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
