Meaning: Parenthetically means in a manner that adds additional information or clarification, often set off by parentheses or as an aside.

1. The professor explained the theory, parenthetically noting its historical context.
2. She interjected parenthetically, making the conversation feel more personal and engaging.
3. The report included, parenthetically, several references to previous research studies.
4. He made a comment, parenthetically, that left everyone in the room intrigued.
5. The book features anecdotes that are, parenthetically, relevant to the main argument.
