Meaning: Paring refers to the act of trimming or reducing something in size or amount, often by cutting away excess, as well as the specific action of peeling or cutting away the outer layer of fruits or vegetables.

1. Paring down the budget allowed the team to allocate funds more effectively.
2. She enjoyed paring apples for the pie, savoring the sweet aroma that filled the kitchen.
3. The artist spent hours paring the clay into delicate shapes for her sculpture.
4. Paring the project requirements helped clarify the goals and streamline the workflow.
