Meaning: Parochialism is a narrow-minded focus on local or trivial concerns, often at the expense of broader perspectives and issues.

1. Parochialism often leads to a narrow perspective that overlooks broader social issues.

3. Her parochialism was evident in her reluctance to engage with people from different backgrounds.
