Meaning: To parochialize means to restrict or narrow the focus of a discussion or perspective to local or limited issues, often at the expense of broader or more universal considerations.

1. Efforts to parochialize the debate limited the scope of the discussion to local issues.
2. By focusing solely on their own community, they risked parochializing the broader implications of the policy.
3. The author criticized the tendency of some scholars to parochialize their research, ignoring global perspectives.
4. In an increasingly interconnected world, parochializing our views can lead to misunderstandings and conflict.
5. To truly address the challenges we face, we must avoid parochializing our solutions and consider diverse viewpoints.
