*Meaning: PAROCHIALLY: In a manner that is limited to a narrow or local perspective, often disregarding wider or more global considerations.*

1. The committee approached the issue parochially, focusing only on local concerns without considering broader implications.

3. The discussion was parochially framed, ignoring the global context that was essential for understanding the problem.
4. While her opinions were valuable, they often came across as parochially biased, reflecting only her community's needs.
5. In a parochially oriented society, people frequently prioritize their immediate surroundings over the welfare of others.
