Meaning: To particularize means to specify or detail something by providing particular examples or requirements.

1. It is important to particularize the requirements of the project to ensure clarity among all team members.

3. In her presentation, she failed to particularize the steps needed to achieve the desired outcome.
4. To avoid confusion, the contract must particularize each party's responsibilities in detail.
