

PASSIVE

Meaning: Passive refers to a grammatical voice in which the subject receives the action rather than performs it, or describes a state of being inactive or submissive in a given situation.

1. The passive voice in writing often emphasizes the action rather than the subject.
2. She felt that taking a passive role in the discussion was not beneficial for her career.
3. In many cultures, passive behavior can be seen as a sign of humility or respect.
4. The passive construction of the sentence made it unclear who was responsible for the action.
5. Although he preferred to be passive in group settings, his ideas were often the most valuable.
