

PASTERN

Meaning: PASTERN: The part of a horse's leg between the fetlock and the hoof.

1. The veterinarian examined the horse's pastern for any signs of injury.
2. Proper care of a horse's pastern is essential to prevent lameness.
3. During the competition, the rider noticed a swelling in the horse's pastern.
4. She marked the location on the pastern where the horse seemed to be in pain.
