Meaning: Patronized: treated with an apparent kindness that betrays a feeling of superiority, often making the recipient feel belittled or undervalued.

1. She felt patronized when her colleague dismissed her ideas as naive.
2. The artist was frustrated by the way the gallery director patronized her work during the exhibition.
3. Despite her talents, she often found herself in environments where she was patronized rather than respected.
4. He didn't realize that his compliments were coming off as patronizing rather than genuine.
5. The teacher's tone was patronizing, making the students feel belittled rather than encouraged.
