Meaning: Patronizer: a person who treats others in a condescending manner, often speaking to them as if they are less capable or knowledgeable.

3. Instead of offering genuine help, she often acted like a patronizer, which left others feeling belittled.
4. Being a patronizer can damage relationships, as people appreciate sincerity and respect.
5. She preferred constructive feedback over the patronizer's superficial compliments that felt insincere.
