

# PAVISE

*Meaning: PAVISE: A large, portable shield used in medieval warfare to protect soldiers from projectiles, particularly arrows.*

1. The medieval soldier skillfully positioned the pavise to shield himself from enemy arrows.
2. During the siege, the archers relied on their pavises to provide cover while they reloaded their bows.
3. Historians often study the design of pavises to understand the evolution of battlefield tactics in the Middle Ages.
4. The large, decorative pavise stood as both a protective barrier and a symbol of the knight's nobility.
5. Artisans crafted elaborate pavises, painting them with coats of arms to signify allegiance and honor.
