

PECTINEAL

Meaning: Pectineal refers to structures related to or resembling a pecten, particularly in anatomy, where it pertains to the pectineal muscle or pectineal line associated with the pelvis.

1. The pectineal muscle plays a crucial role in hip flexion and adduction.
2. In anatomy, the pectineal line is a significant landmark on the pubis.
3. Surgeons must be careful not to damage the pectineal structures during hip replacement procedures.
4. The pectineal ligament contributes to the stability of the pelvic region.
5. Understanding the pectineal area is essential for diagnosing certain groin injuries.

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
