

PEDICEL

Meaning: Pedicel: a slender stalk that supports a single flower or fruit in a plant.

1. The pedicel of the flower supports the delicate bloom, allowing it to reach towards the sunlight.
2. In the study of botany, the pedicel is important for understanding the structure of plant inflorescences.
3. Some insects, like certain species of spiders, have a pedicel that connects their cephalothorax and abdomen.
