

# PEDICLE

*Meaning: Pedicle: a narrow stalk or supporting structure that connects a vertebra to surrounding tissues in vertebrate anatomy.*

1. The pedicle is a critical structure in vertebrate anatomy, connecting the vertebrae to the surrounding tissues.
2. Surgeons often use pedicles as anchoring points for spinal implants during corrective procedures.
3. In botany, a pedicle refers to the stalk that supports a single flower or fruit in a cluster.

5. Researchers are studying the role of the pedicle in the growth and development of various plant species.
