2. As the curtain rose, the audience leaned forward to peek at the performers on stage.
3. He decided to peek through the keyhole to see if anyone was inside the room.
4. The cat would often peek out from behind the curtains whenever it heard a noise.
5. During the hike, we took a moment to peek over the edge of the cliff and admire the view.
