1. The referee decided to penalize the team for their unsportsmanlike conduct during the match.
2. If students fail to submit their assignments on time, the school will penalize them with a grade reduction.
3. The government plans to penalize companies that violate environmental regulations with hefty fines.
4. In an effort to discourage late arrivals, the employer will penalize employees who repeatedly show up after the start time.
5. Some argue that strict laws may unfairly penalize individuals for minor infractions.
