

PENDENTIVE

Meaning: Pendentive: a curved triangle of vaulting that transitions between the circular base of a dome and the square or polygonal space beneath it, providing structural support in architecture.

1. The artist's pendentive beautifully blended the transition between the dome and the square base of the building.
2. In classical architecture, a pendentive is essential for supporting a dome on a square room.
3. The intricate frescoes painted inside the pendentives added a sense of grandeur to the cathedral.
