

PENICILLIFORM

Meaning: Penicilliform refers to a shape or structure resembling a brush or a tuft, often characterized by slender, elongated parts that can efficiently filter or enhance texture.

1. The penicilliform structure of the coral polyps allows them to filter feed efficiently.
