

PENUMBRA

Meaning: Penumbra refers to the partially shaded outer region of a shadow, especially during an eclipse, or a gradual transition between light and shadow in art.

1. The penumbra of the moon cast a soft shadow over the landscape during the lunar eclipse.
2. Artists often use the concept of penumbra to create a sense of depth in their paintings.
3. As the sun set, a beautiful penumbra enveloped the horizon, blurring the lines between day and night.
4. In astronomy, the penumbra is the region where partial shadow occurs during an eclipse.
5. The mysterious penumbra surrounding the figure in the photograph added an air of intrigue to the image.
