Meaning: Perceptivity is the ability to notice and understand things quickly and accurately, particularly in relation to others' emotions and subtle nuances.

1. Her perceptivity allowed her to understand the emotions of others without them saying a word.
2. The artist's perceptivity was evident in the way she captured the subtleties of human expression in her paintings.
3. In negotiations, his perceptivity gave him an advantage, as he could sense when the other party was hesitant.
4. The teacher's perceptivity helped her identify students who were struggling, even when they didn't voice their concerns.
5. Developing perceptivity can enhance one's ability to connect with others on a deeper level.
