Meaning: Percipient (noun): a person who perceives or is capable of perceiving, especially in a way that engages deeply with sensory or emotional experiences.

1. The artist's intention was to challenge the percipient to engage deeply with the emotions conveyed in the painting.
2. In philosophy, a percipient is often considered essential for the process of perception to take place.
3. Her sensitivity as a percipient allowed her to interpret the subtle nuances in the poem.
