*Meaning: **PERFOLIATE**: (verb) To shed leaves or foliage, particularly in response to environmental changes or seasonal cycles.*

1. The botanist explained how certain plants can perfoliate in response to environmental changes.
2. As autumn approached, the trees began to perfoliate, shedding their leaves in vibrant hues.
3. To ensure the plant's health, the gardener decided to perfoliate the branches for better sunlight exposure.

5. The artist used perfoliate techniques in her painting to create a textured, dynamic effect.
