

PERFORATE

Meaning: To perforate means to make a series of small holes in a material to facilitate separation or bending.

1. The technician will perforate the metal sheet to allow for easier bending.
2. Students often perforate their paper to create tear-out sections in notebooks.
3. The artist decided to perforate the canvas to add an interesting texture to her painting.
4. To create a decorative edge, she used a special tool to perforate the cardstock.
5. The new design features a perforated pattern that enhances airflow in the shoes.
