

PERFORATIVE

Meaning: Perforative (adjective): relating to a speech act or verb that effects change or creates a new state of affairs through its utterance.

1. The perforative nature of the speech act transformed the audience's understanding of the issue.
2. In linguistics, a perforative verb can change the state of affairs simply by being uttered.
3. The artist's work was a perforative expression of identity and culture.
4. During the debate, her perforative statements challenged the conventional views held by the panel.
5. The poem's use of language was not just descriptive but also perforative, invoking action and reflection.
