Meaning: Perimetry is the measurement of the visual field to assess vision and detect abnormalities.

1. Perimetry tests are often used to assess a patient's visual field and detect any abnormalities.
2. The ophthalmologist recommended perimetry to better understand the patient's vision loss.
3. Advancements in technology have improved the accuracy of automated perimetry significantly.
4. During the eye exam, the technician explained how perimetry would help identify potential issues in peripheral vision.
