Meaning: In a manner characterized by the use of more words than necessary, often to explain or elaborate on a concept.

1. The concept was explained periphrastically to ensure clarity for all participants.
2. She tended to express her thoughts periphrastically, often using more words than necessary.
3. In academic writing, ideas are sometimes conveyed periphrastically to avoid ambiguity.
4. The author crafted his narrative periphrastically, emphasizing subtleties through elaborate descriptions.
5. To avoid misunderstanding, he answered periphrastically, elaborating on every point he made.
