

PERITRACHEAL

Meaning: Peritracheal refers to the area surrounding the trachea, often relating to swelling or pressure in that region.

1. The surgeon noted significant peritracheal swelling during the examination.
2. Increased peritracheal pressure can indicate complications following tracheostomy.
3. The imaging revealed extensive peritracheal inflammation surrounding the airway.
4. A peritracheal abscess was diagnosed, requiring immediate surgical intervention.
5. The patient's symptoms were consistent with a peritracheal infection due to recent intubation.

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
