Meaning: PERMEABLY: In a manner that allows substances, such as liquids or gases, to pass through or diffuse.

1. The water seeped permeably through the porous soil, nourishing the roots of the plants.
2. In the experiment, the gas diffused permeably across the membrane, demonstrating its selective permeability.
3. The fabric was designed to be permeably breathable, allowing moisture to escape while keeping the wearer dry.
