

PERMIT

Meaning: Permit (verb): To allow or authorize something to happen or be done.

1. The city council decided to permit the construction of a new park in the neighborhood.
2. To enter the restricted area, you must obtain a special permit from the authorities.
3. She was thrilled to receive a permit to host her art exhibition in the gallery.
4. The company requires a permit for any employee to work overtime during the holidays.
