

PERPENDICLE

Meaning: Perpendicular (adjective): Describing a line or surface that is at a right angle to another line or surface, specifically indicating a relationship of perpendicularity.

1. The architect emphasized the importance of ensuring that every wall was perfectly perpendicular to the foundation.
2. In geometry class, we learned that a line is perpendicular to a plane if it intersects the plane at a right angle.
3. The designer used a perpendicular layout for the garden to create a sense of symmetry and balance.
4. When constructing the fence, the workers checked to make sure each post was perpendicular to the ground for stability.
5. The artist depicted the landscape with a perpendicular horizon line to enhance the depth of the painting.
