2. Scientists are concerned that environmental changes could perturb the delicate balance of the ecosystem.
3. His constant questions began to perturb the teacher, who was trying to maintain order in the classroom.
4. Even a small mistake in the calculations could perturb the entire outcome of the experiment.
5. The loud music from the neighboring apartment did little to perturb her concentration while studying.
