2. She approached the problem perversedly, choosing the most complicated solution when a simple one was available.
3. PERVERSEDLY, he twisted her words to fit his narrative, ignoring her actual intentions.
4. The artist perversedly depicted reality, turning ordinary scenes into bizarre representations.
5. Their perversedly optimistic outlook on failure led them to repeat the same mistakes time and again.
