

PHOTOSPHERE

Meaning: Photosphere: the luminous outer layer of a star, particularly the Sun, from which visible light is emitted.

1. The photosphere of the Sun is the layer that emits visible light.

3. The temperature of the photosphere is approximately 5,500 degrees Celsius.
