*Meaning: To physiologize means to analyze or interpret behaviors and emotional responses in terms of physiological processes or biological functions.*

1. In order to better understand human behavior, researchers began to physiologize various emotional responses.
2. The professor encouraged her students to physiologize their observations of animal behavior in the lab.
3. Psychologists often physiologize complex thoughts to illustrate how they relate to biological processes.
4. To achieve a more profound insight into motivation, the team decided to physiologize the participants' reactions during the study.
5. By choosing to physiologize the symptoms, the doctor was able to connect the patient's experience to underlying physiological issues.
