Meaning: PILIFORM: resembling or having the shape of a hair or filament, often used to describe structures in organisms that aid in camouflage or sensory functions.

1. The piliform structure of the caterpillar's body helps it blend into the surrounding foliage.
2. In her research on insect anatomy, she discovered that many species exhibit piliform bristles to aid in sensory perception.
3. The scientist noted that the piliform characteristics of the fungus were key to its identification.
