

PLACEBO

Meaning: A placebo is a substance with no therapeutic effect, often used in clinical trials as a control to compare the effects of an actual medication.

1. The study revealed that the patients who received the placebo experienced significant improvements in their symptoms.
2. Researchers often use a placebo to determine the effectiveness of new medications in clinical trials.
3. Despite knowing they were given a placebo, many participants reported feeling better after taking the sugar pill.
4. The placebo effect can sometimes lead to real physiological changes in the body, demonstrating the power of the mind.
5. In the experiment, the group that received the placebo showed similar results to those who took the actual drug.
