Meaning: Placitory: intended to soothe or pacify, often used to describe remarks or tones that aim to alleviate tension or conflict.

1. The lawyer's placitory remarks helped to ease the tensions in the courtroom.
2. Her placitory tone suggested that she was trying to smooth over the disagreement.
3. Despite his placitory gestures, the audience remained skeptical of his intentions.
4. The manager made a placitory offer to appease the disgruntled employees.
5. In moments of conflict, a placitory approach can often lead to more constructive dialogue.
