

PLANE-PARALLEL

Meaning: Plane-parallel refers to two or more surfaces or lines that are aligned in the same plane and maintain a constant distance apart without intersecting.

1. The architect designed the building with a plane-parallel facade to enhance its modern aesthetic.
2. In physics, two lines are considered plane-parallel when they lie in the same plane and never intersect.
3. The artist used plane-parallel layers of color to create depth in the abstract painting.
4. To achieve the desired effect, the photographer ensured that the horizon was perfectly plane-parallel to the edge of the frame.
5. In geology, plane-parallel bedding is an important feature that can indicate the depositional environment of sedimentary rocks.
