

PLANTIGRADE

Meaning: Plantigrade refers to a mode of locomotion in which an animal walks on the soles of its feet, as seen in mammals like bears and humans.

1. Many mammals, such as bears and humans, are classified as plantigrade because they walk on the soles of their feet.
2. The plantigrade locomotion of the raccoon allows it to move quietly while foraging for food.
3. Unlike digitigrade animals, plantigrade species have a more stable base of support when walking.

10. The study of locomotion often contrasts plantigrade and digitigrade species in their movement efficiency.

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
