Meaning: PLASTERY: resembling or consisting of plaster; having a smooth, thick, and often malleable texture used for coating surfaces.

1. The old walls were covered in a thick layer of plastery material that had cracked over the years.

3. The artist preferred a plastery texture for her sculptures, as it allowed for intricate detailing.
