*Meaning: To plausibleize means to make a statement, idea, or theory seem reasonable or credible by providing supporting evidence or justification.*

1. The detective needed to plausibleize the suspect's alibi to find the truth.
2. In her analysis, she sought to plausibleize the theory by incorporating new evidence.
3. To win the debate, he had to plausibleize his argument with credible sources.
4. The author tried to plausibleize the plot twist, making it more believable for the readers.
5. Researchers often strive to plausibleize their hypotheses to gain acceptance in the scientific community.
