1. She explained her theory so convincingly that it seemed plausibly true.
2. The detective's reasoning was sound, and he plausibly linked the suspect to the crime scene.
3. In her essay, she plausibly argued that climate change is accelerating due to human activity.
4. The scientist presented data that plausibly supported his hypothesis about the new drug's effectiveness.
5. Despite initial doubts, the proposal was plausibly defended during the board meeting.
