

PLEONASM

Meaning: Pleonasm is the use of more words than necessary to convey meaning, often resulting in redundancy, such as in the phrase "free gift."

1. A common example of pleonasm is the phrase "free gift," since a gift is inherently free.
2. In writing, the use of pleonasm can sometimes add emphasis, but it often leads to redundancy.
3. The expression "ATM machine" is a classic case of pleonasm, as the "M" in ATM already stands for machine.
4. Writers should be cautious of pleonasm, as it can dilute the clarity and impact of their message.
5. She winced at the pleonasm in his speech, knowing it made him sound less articulate than he truly was.
